Other Designations for the People of God

We noticed last week that the pre-eminent name for the individual people of God today is the name "Christian." It was prophesied by Isaiah 700 years before it was fulfilled in Acts 11:26! No other name is to be worn preeminently today, even in a hyphenated sense. The name "Christian" is for individuals, not the church. It is authorized by God and is the Scriptural designation for God's people in this The term "Christian" shows our age. relationship to Christ, and in wearing this name we honor Christ, and glorify God (I Pet. 4:16). Though this name is the pre-eminent name, other designations are used by the Holy Spirit suggest different relationships Christians have toward each other, toward God, and toward Christ. Notice some of these:

- 1. "BELIEVER" This suggests the faith of the Christian in Christ (Acts 4:32).
- 2. "SAINT"—This is not applied to dead people in the Bible! It suggests the followers of Christ are separated from the world and dedicated to holy service (Acts 9:13).

- 3. "PRIEST" Applied to all Christians, because all Christians are to "offer up spiritual sacrifices (worship) acceptable to God by Jesus Christ" (I Pet. 2:5 Jn. 4:24; Acts 2:42).
- 4. "DISCIPLE" This term suggests that Christians are followers, learners, or students (Acts 9:25, 28).
- 5. "BRETHREN" This shows our mutual relationship one with another "in Christ" or His church (Acts 9:30; Mt. 23:8).
- 6. "CHILDREN" Shows that God is our Father (Gal. 3:26; Rom. 8: 17).
- 7. "SERVANTS" Suggesting that
 Christ is our Master and Lord (Eph. 6:6).

These and other terms and phrases are found in the Holy Scriptures to show the relationship which we sustain to God and Christ, the church and the world, and to one another. But again, the pre-eminent name to designate the followers of Christ is the Godgiven name "Christian."
