Where in the Bible Will I Find . . . The Way to a Rewarding Marriage?

The Bible is a wonderful book. It is the only book that gives us the right formulas for successful government, a rewarding marriage, and the pattern for the New Testament church. It contains all things that pertain to life and Godliness (II Pet. 1:3). It will thoroughly furnish the man of God unto every good work (II Tim. 3:16-17). To add to it, subtract from it, or ignore it, brings ruin (Jn. 8:31-32). But if it is followed, it will bless our lives abundantly. Too many in our time have never read the Bible with any consistency, if they have read it at all. One said correctly, "When all else fails, read the instructions." We truly hope that more will read the Bible BEFORE their marriage, in order to have the happiness and joy intended by God in this divine relationship. When God set marriage in order, He gave the way it would be successful (Gen. 2:18-25). Although Moses altered God's original law to protect women during the time before the Law of Moses was removed (Col. 2:14-19), his rule was only allowed by God for a season (Deut. 24; Acts 17:30-31). Jesus, in His New Testament, returned all mankind to the original law of Jehovah, and quoted from the original instructions given by God (Matt. 19:3-9). Recently in **The Tennessean**, a Philadelphia psychologist was quoted as saying that she finds marriage to be "antiquated and unworkable" in today's society. Though we are not personally acquainted with Mr. Rob Mossack, we thought he did a fine job of answering this psychologist. He stated:

The lady doesn't seem to understand what marriage is all about! Marriage is an arena for learning how to love and serve another person, not have my "personal happiness" fulfilled. It is a relationship that calls for me to give myself to another completely, while she does the same for me. It requires the development of patience, the exercise of forgiveness, and the discipline of commitment. It can often be a demanding relationship, one in which both parties have to sacrifice self. Interestingly enough, real joy is found when couples "do" marriage the way it was intended to be done. The joy that comes from shared sacrifice and mutual commitment far exceeds the situational, transitional "personal happiness" our society obsessively seeks through self-indulgence. It's that selfish pursuit of our own interests that is the problem, not the nature of marriage. We don't need to discard marriage; we need to rediscover what really matters in life!

Our comment on Mr. Mossack's writing is, "Well done!" Some, it appears, have become too smart for God and His Word, but then Paul says of them, "Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools" (Rom. 1:22). Let's not join them!
