God's Plan for the Home (Pt. 3)

For the last few weeks, we have been studying God's plan for the home and some changes that some have tried to make. The last two issues have been dealing with husband and wife. We may come back and deal with more issues along those lines at a later date, but our focus will now shift to the relationship between parent and child. One cannot help but see how important parents are in the lives of children. We have many Biblical examples of good parents (Abraham and Sarah, Noah and his wife, etc.). We also have Biblical examples of bad parents (Rebekah, Eli, etc.).







While there is no set way that the Bible says that children must be reared, there are several Biblical precedents and standards which should be followed. One such passage is this, "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it" (Pro. 22:6). What does this passage mean? It **does not** mean that if a child is unfaithful, it is the fault of the parents. Each person has the ability to choose what he or she will do in this life (Jos. 24:15). It **does** mean that the parents have a responsibility to teach their children what is right so that when these children grow up, they know the right way from the wrong way.

How would a child know right from wrong if he or she is not taught by his or her parents? Parents should teach their children about God's plan of salvation, the need to worship God properly (Eph. 5:19), the importance of the blood of Christ (Mat. 26:28), the distinctive nature of the church (Mat. 16:18), the perfectness of God's Word (2 Tim. 3:16-17), the importance of studying the Bible (2 Tim. 2:15), the need to live as God has commanded (Mat. 5:14-16), and many other topics which will be vital when that child is of the age of accountability. If a child is given a solid base at home, he or she will be better equipped once they go out on their own.

This is not intended to be a condemnation of those who have unfaithful children. As was stated earlier, parents can do everything right, yet the child may decide that he or she wants to live contrary to God's Word. We are merely saying that if parents give the proper diligence to teach their children, those children will be better off when they must make their own decisions.

Thank you for your time. Lord willing, we will continue with this study of God's plan for the home next week.
