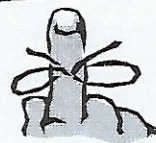

The Only Day That Is Promised

Many of you remember the year 1999. The year that everyone started to get nervous due to Y2K. The year 2000. The technology was thought to not be able to cross into the new century. I remember this very well. I was only 15 at the time but I can recall all the panics that many people experience. Banks, schools and other businesses invested thousands of dollars simply because they did not know if their software would turn from 1999 to 2000. People were even pulling their money out of the banks because they did not know if the banks would make it through the big change. I know there is more to it than that but everyone prepared for that day.

Now, over the past few months, there have been millions of people flocking to the grocery stores. They have been worried about getting sick from a virus that is 'new' to the world. This new strand of the COVID virus has taken people by surprise. People are buying paper towels, sanitizer, hand wipes, and even toilet paper because they are afraid they are going to get sick.
