From The Desk Of Bradley Smith




“But God”

The phrase, “but God,” appears 44 times in the King James Version of the Bible. It is applied in several different ways. One way that it is applied is in the sense of man intending to do one thing, but God caused something else to happen (Gen. 20:3, Gen. 31:7, Gen. 50:20, 1 Sam. 23:14, 1 Chr. 28:13, Pro. 21:12, Jonah 4:7, Luke 12:20, Acts 7:9, Acts 13:30). God does not act miraculously today as He did in many of these cases (1 Cor. 13:8-10). However, one passage that utilizes the phrase, “but God,” should stand out in our mind. “**But God** commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us (Rom. 5:8, emp: mine, BMS).”

When we think about God’s love for us, what can we do but thank Him? God’s grace is extended through us all through His Son (Eph. 2:8-10, Heb. 5:8-9). How could we not love God (1 John 4:19). God’s love is abundantly shown. He desires all to be saved (1 Tim. 2:4, 2 Pet. 3:9).

Dear friend, if you’ve never obeyed the Gospel of Christ, God wants you to, as do we. The Biblical model is simply followed: Hear the Gospel (1 Cor. 15:1-4), Have Faith (John 3:16), Repent of Your Sins (Acts 2:38), Confess Your Faith in Christ (Acts 8:37), Be Baptized into Christ (Rom. 6:3-4), and Live Faithfully to Him (1 John 1:7). You may be living a dark life, “but God” wants you to be in the light.
