ON THE HOME FRONT

Reflect on Psalm 9 this week

- ¹I will praise thee, O LORD, with my whole heart; I will shew forth all thy marvelous works.
- ²I will be glad and rejoice in thee: I will sing praise to thy name, O thou most High.
- ³When mine enemies are turned back, they shall fall and perish at thy presence.
- ⁴For thou hast maintained my right and my cause; thou satest in the throne judging right.
- ⁵Thou hast rebuked the heathen, thou hast destroyed the wicked, thou hast put out their name for ever and ever.
- ⁶O thou enemy, destructions are come to a perpetual end: and thou hast destroyed cities; their memorial is perished with them.
- ⁷But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment.
- ⁸And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.
- ⁹The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble.
- ¹⁰And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.
- ¹¹Sing praises to the LORD, which dwelleth in Zion: declare among the people his doings.
- ¹²When he maketh inquisition for blood, he remembereth them: he forgetteth not the cry of the humble.
- ¹³Have mercy upon me, O LORD; consider my trouble which I suffer of them that hate me, thou that liftest me up from the gates of death:
- ¹⁴That I may shew forth all thy praise in the gates of the daughter of Zion: I will rejoice in thy salvation.
- ¹⁵The heathen are sunk down in the pit that they made: in the net which they hid is their own foot taken.
- ¹⁶The LORD is known by the judgment which he executeth: the wicked is snared in the work of his own hands. Higgaiou. Selah.
- ¹⁷The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God.
- ¹⁸For the needy shall not always be forgotten: the expectation of the poor shall not perish for ever.
- ¹⁹Arise, O LORD; let not man prevail: let the heathen be judged in thy sight.
- ²⁰Put them in fear, O LORD: that the nations may know themselves to be but men. Selah.

GOD IS FAITHFUL

The LORD is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works. The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth. He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them. The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.



(Psalms 145:17-20)

David, in this Psalm of praise (145), extols God as his God, and says that he will bless and praise the name of God for ever and ever. And in the closing verses of this chapter, he tells why:

1. **God's righteousness and holiness.** That God is righteous and holy is seen throughout the Scriptures. Psalms 111:9, ". . . holy and reverend is his name." Paul warned of some ". . . being ignorant of God's righteousness..." set about to establish their own (Rom.10:2,3)
2. **God is nigh to all who call upon Him in truth.** James tells us that if we draw nigh to God, that He will draw nigh to us (Jas. 4:8). But notice the condition that the Psalmist adds, "to all that call upon him in truth." Jesus' prayer to the Father included, "... thy word is truth" (Jn. 17:17).
3. **He will fulfill the desire of them that fear Him.** The wise man concluded the meaning of life with, ". . . Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man" (Eccl. 12:12). The desires of those who fear God is seen in Jesus' words, "... not as I will, but as thou wilt" (Matt. 26:39). Our desires become the same as His.
4. **He hears the cries of those who fear Him.** The Psalmist had said earlier, "The eyes of the Lord are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry" (Psa. 34: 15). Peter repeated the same thing, "For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers..." (1 Pet. 3:12).
5. **He will save those who fear Him.** The Hebrew writer shows the extent of such salvation with these words: "Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them" (Heb. 7:25). "I will call upon God; and the LORD shall save me" (Psa. 55:16).
6. **He will preserve those that love Him.** Psalms 16: 1, "Preserve me, O God: for in thee do I put my trust." And Paul wrote, "and the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom..." (2 Tim. 4: 18).
7. **He will destroy the wicked.** The Psalmist's confidence that God would deal with the wicked and destroy them was a source of strength to David. Paul wrote that the Lord will come "In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ" (2 Thess. 1:8).

Truly, God is worthy to be extolled and praised, for ever and ever.
